#### **Overview - Mission Statement**

The mission of the new higher education data website is to provide indicators of college affordability, diversity, and student success on campus to policymakers and the public.

By making relevant information easy to access and analyze, we hope to **enable research and inform policies** to make college more available and affordable to people of all backgrounds.



#### **Overview - Data**

- Easy-to-use profiles and research-level data for almost 5,000 US colleges
  - Also calculated totals and averages for states, sectors, and other groupings of colleges
- Over 150 variables topics include student debt, affordability, racial diversity, economic diversity, and student success
- 6 years of data: 2000-01, 2003-04, 2004-05, 2005-06, 2006-07, 2007-08
- Sources: IPEDS, Pell, FISAP, CDS







 Begin typing your query into the "search by name" field at the top of the Spotlight page, choose from the list that appears below, then click "go."

















#### **Topics**

The Topics tab allows you to focus on a particular issue, then dig deeper to see how specific colleges, states, or types of schools compare.



#### Step one: Select topic


Choose a topic from the drop-down menu to the left and click "go." You will be presented with national-level data on that topic, displayed in tables and charts. You can download the table as a spreadsheet or print the page.



## Step two: Customize your list of colleges, states, or school types

Select up to six different colleges, states, or types of school through either of the following search methods:

- To search by name, begin typing your query into the field that says "enter name of college, state, or sector," choose from the list that appears below, and click "select."
- To search by criteria, such as location, size, demographics, and cost, click on "advanced search". Select values for one or more filters, then click "show list." A list of colleges, states, or school types meeting your criteria will appear. Select up to six entities and click "add to list."








#### **Explore All Data**

The Explore All Data tab allows you to build a table for any combination of colleges, variables, or years in the College InSight database.



## Step one: Choose colleges, states, or school types

Select using either of the following methods or a combination of both:

- To search by name, begin typing your query into the field that says "enter name of college, state, or sector," choose from the list that appears below, and click "select."
- To search by criteria, such as location, size, demographics, and cost, click on "advanced search". Select values for one or more filters, then click "show list." A list of colleges, states, or school types meeting your criteria will appear. Select one or more entities and click "add to list."

Your choices will be added to the box labeled "You Selected" on the left.





To search by name or keyword, begin typing your query (such as "Pell" or "loans") into the field that says "enter variable name." Choose from the list that annears below and click "select."





























