Process

Idea initiation = critical functions with repeated requests for support

Brainstorming/storyboarding = articulate purpose, develop content, visuals (PowerPoint), graphics, draft scripts

Production = script re-writes, visual re-writes, and digital audio recording

Post-production = audio editing (cuts), vocal editing (voice stability, clarity), music and visuals, captioning, file conversion (to iTunes and Windows Media File)

Dissemination = Loading files to server, developing webpage, announcements to campus

Insights

Leveraging component important—requirement to view podcast prior to requesting resources or additional support, including training

Early collaboration with multimedia critical

Non-copyrighted material

Audio recording is acting! Be prepared for re-takes!

Need to couple with live training (e.g., staff development)

Need to include visual instructions (e.g., screen shots) of how to access and download media



Future Directions

Enhanced podcast to vodcast—motion, visual representation

Move to modular instruction--longer to shorter segments, topically driven

Expansion to annual planning, assessment, and ARCC

Incorporate an assessment component for podcast for purposes of program review for institutional research



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
