






Global Economy and Increasing Competition



Current and Expected Postsecondary Attainment--United States




Closing the Gap—Number of Degrees Required Beyond Current Production

A 50% Increase in Higher Education Degrees Needed by 2020









Retirement-Aged Increasing Faster than College-Aged in California











Enrollment Planning for Higher Education Involves More Birth Rates and K-12 Continuation Rates to Graduation
